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# I. ខ្លឹមសារនៃមុខវិជ្ជា Course Description

This is the first of two courses in mental health nursing. In this course, students will be introduced to environmental and psychological factors that influence the mental health and wellbeing of people at different stages of their life. Behaviors causing concern will be discussed along with both risk factors and protective factors. There will be a focus on common mental health disorders and how substance use in these different situations, with different age groups, impacts on the patient outcome. Moreover, the students are

introduced to mental health nursing as a specialty area of practice. In this course, students will learn about the role of the nurse in screening, assessment and intervention of people with mental health illnesses. There will be a focus on the assessment of specific patient scenarios using case management to enhance students' application of knowledge and skills. The course will also cover illness prevention and health promotion in detail including specific needs at different ages across the life span, different socio-economic groups and different life experiences across a range of settings including hospitals and the community.

#### Learning & Teaching Modes:

In this course, lecturers will use a student-centered approach and support students to take responsibility for their learning. Learning and teaching will also be underpinned by competency-based learning which supports students to apply evidence-based practice into to practical settings in the future;

Thus, in this course, the lecturers will provide the students with both knowledge and skills with a variety of teaching methods:

**Direct instruction**: Lecturers would provide lecturing to the whole class with the clear instruction on each session based on the course syllabus/outline. Lecturers would explain some of the basic points and call students for revision at the end of each class.

**Group discussion**: Students are required to work in groups either in class or outside class in order to submit the tasks that have been assigned by the lecturer.

**Blended/Flipped classroom**: Students are required to read material and present what they have read to the classmates and lecturer in class. The reading material will be uploaded in UPOP (Moodle) or lecturers may provide extra learning materials in class.

**UPOP/Moodle**: Each student is required to self-study via UPOP (UP online learning Platform) by completing all tasks that have been assigned by the lecturer in that online classroom. This

online learning would be graded automatically recorded and contribute the score to the inclass learning.
