This course is an introduction to the processes of gerontology and the study of all aspects of the aging process including the clinical, psychologic, economic, and sociological problems of the older adults and the consequences of these problems for older adults and society. Gerontology nursing is to safeguard and increase health to the extent possible and to provide comfort and care to the extent necessary. This subject focuses on gerontic nursing. It

addresses ways to promote high-level functioning and methods of providing care by using nursing processes and comfort for older adults.

V. វិធីសាស្ត្រវៀន និងបង្រៀន Learning & Teaching (L&T) Methodologies:

Study Workload

The information provided below is a guide to assist you in planning your studies and the minimum contact time expected for this course.

Learning & teaching modes:

In this semester, you will be required to attend 3 hours face to face class per week [3hx5 weeks], and 1 hours of independent/group work session every week for 5 weeks [1 h x 5 weeks]. Lecturer(s) will assess your work at various stages throughout the course both during and after the teaching period.

a. Direct instruction: Lecturers would provide lecturing to the whole class with the clear instruction on each session based on the course syllabus/outline. Lecturers would explain some of the basic points and call students for revision at the end of each class.

b. Group discussion: Students are required to work in groups either in class or outside class in order to submit the tasks that have been assigned by lecturer.

c. Blended/Flipped classroom: Students are required to read material and present what they have read to the classmates and lecturer in class. The reading material will be uploaded in UPOP (Moodle) or lecturers may provide extra learning materials in class.

d. UPOP/Moodle: Each student is required to self-study via UPOP (UP online learning Platform) by completing all tasks that have been assigned by lecturer in that online classroom. This online learning would be graded automatically recorded and contribute the score to the in-class learning.
