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I. ខ្លឹមសារនៃមុខវិជ្ជា Course Description:

This course is designed for nursing students to understand the overview of mental health, mental disorders and other factors that cause mental problems. Moreover, students will be able to recognize the signs and symptoms of the diseases which will be used for creating nursing diagnoses to promote healthy mental status of individual, family and community. In this course, there will be a discussion about assessment of an individual's mental status, behavior, thinking process and emotions of patients with challenging mental illness and

In the chapter describing signs and symptoms of mental illness which can't be described by the medicine, students will understand and recognize problems that lead to insomnia and exhaustion, physical dysfunction, anxiety, signs and symptoms which cannot be explained by medicine.

V. វិធីសាស្ត្ររៀន និងបង្រៀន Learning and Teaching (L&T) Methodologies:

The information provided below is a guide to assist you in planning your studies and the minimum contact time expected for this course.

9 hours Facilitated work per week (x5)	45 Hours

Learning & Teaching Modes:

In this semester, you will be required to attend 9 hours face to face class per week [9 h \times 5 weeks], and 4 hours of independent/group work session every week for 5 weeks [4 h \times 5 weeks]. Lecturer(s) will assess your work at various stages throughout the course both during and after the teaching period.

- a. **Direct instruction**: Lecturers would provide lecturing to the whole class with the clear instruction on each session based on the course syllabus/outline. Lecturers would explain some of the basic points and call students for revision at the end of each class.
- b. **Group discussion**: Students are required to work in groups either in class or outside class in order to submit the tasks that have been assigned by lecturer.
- c. **Blended/Flipped classroom**: Students are required to read material and present what they have read to the classmates and lecturer in class. The reading material will be uploaded in UPOP (Moodle) or lecturers may provide extra learning materials in class.
- d. **UPOP/Moodle**: Each student is required to self-study via UPOP (UP online learning Platform) by completing all tasks that have been assigned by lecturer in that online classroom. This online learning would be graded automatically recorded and contribute the score to the in-class learning.
