Course Learning Outcomes

- 1 Describe the host response to infections
- 2 Describe common symptoms and signs of infection in each body system
- 3 Discuss common causes of infections by body site of disease
- 4 Describe mode of transmission of common infections
- Discuss general and nursing specific measures to prevent common infections in Cambodia

Course Content

• **Session:** 20 sessions in 10 weeks

3 hours facilitated classroom via UPOP (10 weeks)	30 hours

Learning and Teaching Method

- Lecture: Lecturers would provide lecturing to the whole class and explain some of the basic points.
- Think-pair-share: students reflect by themselves individually before discussing with a peer, and then share with the entire class.
- Peer feedback: Each student gives feedback to his/her peer with facilitation and support form the lecturer.
- Group discussion: Students are required to work in groups either in class or outside class in order to submit the tasks that have been assigned by the lecturer
- Video: Students watch a video related to the topic

Learning and Teaching Method (Con't)

- Concept mapping: Students work individually or as a team to draw a map indicating relationships between key ideas from the lesson.
- Case study: Students work on solving the case study assigned by their lecturer.
- **Mini-presentation:** Lecturer asks individual or group to present on a key concept/key summary from the session.
- Group reflection: Small groups discuss what they've learned and understood and any unclear points
- UPOP/Moodle: Each student is required to Reviewing/self-study via UPOP (UP online learning Platform) by completing all tasks that have been assigned by the lecturer in that online classroom.
